



Defining - Brainstorm with your group to find out what you know. Use the [KWL](#) chart to record what you already know and what you will need to find out. Use this chart to track your learning.

Locating - Go to the library and online resources pages and start reading about the topic. It is good to have some knowledge before you start your information searching. Keep in mind the qualities that make a good information source.

Selecting - Use key words to help in your search. [The Tic-tac-toe](#) will help with note-taking. Remember to keep a record of the information you use for your reference list.

Organising - [The Cluster Word Web 3](#) will help organise your information into similar groups.

Present your information in your chosen format; Information report, artwork, drama, PowerPoint, Movie maker, music. Check with your teacher for assessment requirements.
